All HAS Participating Members....

Each exhibiting Member can exhibit 1, 2, or 3 Art works. The Art Drop-Off dates ARE **Friday, May 13, 4:00 PM to 8:00PM and Saturday, May 14, 11 AM to 2PM**. All Gallery show art must be approved by members of the Gallery committee and will be hung **ONLY** by Gallery committee members. **No Art will be accepted after Saturday, May 14 Gallery hours.**

Each Gallery exhibit period will be for 2 months and all exhibiting artists will be notified by email 2 weeks before the Art changeover date in end-July. **ART Work**

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Exhibiting Artist Checklist of to-do items for the Gallery Show

The following checklist of important "to-do" items require your signed art show entry acknowledgement of to-do's.

1. This is a 2-month ART showing and each artist is responsible for their art removal on dates to be provided after the opening.
2. ALL artists are responsible to fill empty wall art space after all sales
3. All participants in the Gallery must be current members of Hollis Arts Society (HAS). Click here to [Download HAS 2022 Membership Application](#)
4. All Gallery participating members must submit a brief bio and current headshot prior to submitting your artwork for the Gallery display book
5. Everyone with artwork hanging in the Gallery on Pearl Street must volunteer to staff the gallery once a month for the duration of your Gallery participation. This is a 4-hour commitment on either a Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.
6. Substitutes for member' absence on assigned days/times is the responsibility of the artist.
7. All artworks will be hung and displayed at the discretion of the HAS Gallery Committee. If you have special requests please note them on your submission form. We cannot guarantee that all requests will be possible.
8. All artwork in the Gallery on Pearl Street will be available for purchase. The artist retains 75% of the price, remaining 25% is designated for the non-profits HAS, and Greater Nashua Mental Health.
9. Hanging Artwork can be no larger than 48". (At this time, we are not accepting miniatures (anything less than 4" square)
10. Artwork must be original art only.
11. Artwork of any medium will be accepted i.e., photography, oil painting, acrylic, collage, jewelry, ceramics, etc.
12. Hanging Artwork is presently limited to 2 or 3 pieces from each artist
13. The art pieces on display should be titled and priced for sale
14. 2D artwork must be ready to hang with a wire attachment; no sawtooth hangers or D hooks will be accepted.
15. Artwork must be dropped off on designated May 13 and 14 Gallery hours
16. All participating Gallery artists will have a completed and signed entry form.

HAS Liability Release: HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

This hold harmless agreement is entered into by and between the Hollis Art Society (hereinafter "the Society"), and members of the Hollis Art Society (hereinafter "Members" of The Hollis Art Society). In lieu of providing proof of liability insurance, 'the Society' and its members agree as follows:

1. "The Society" and its members desire to display works of art at the Gallery on East Pearl at 100 West Pearl Street, Nashua NH (adjacent to/at the Offices of the GNMH facility on 100 West Pearl Street, Nashua NH.
2. The Members will identify and hold harmless the Hollis Art Society from any and all claims, actions, and judgments, including all costs of defense and attorney's fees incurred in defending against same, arising from and related to the Society and its Members use of the premises located at 100 West Pearl Street, Nashua NH which include the acts of the Society's agents and Members use of said premises.
3. The Members further agreed to hold harmless, indemnify and protect, at their own expense, the Hollis Art Society and its agents, from any and all claims arising out of the Society and its members use of the building located at 100 West Pearl Street, Nashua NH, but not limited to, any and all works of art on display in said premises and viewed by the general public.
4. This agreement shall remain in force and effect on a month-to-month basis for a period to be determined by the Hollis Art Society.
